# OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS CITY OF MORGAN CITY DECEMBER 20, 2022

The Mayor and City Council of Morgan City, Louisiana, met at 6:00 pm (local time) in regular session, this date, in the City Court Building, Highway 182 East, Morgan City, Louisiana.

There were present: Honorable Lee Dragna, Mayor; and Council Members Ron Bias, Steve Domangue, Tim Hymel and Louis J. Tamporello, Jr.

Absent: Mark Stephens.

Also present were Mr. Charlie Solar, Jr., Chief Administrative Officer and Mr. Paul Landry, City Attorney.

The invocation was given by Reverend Wendell Howse.

Mr. Raymond "Mac" Wade, Port of Morgan City President, gave a brief update to the Council. He stated that currently we had the best channel in history and the whole channel was currently open. This was great for businesses in the area. There were currently three quarter boats being built for the US Navy at Conrad Shipyards, with the possibility of ten more after those were complete. There were Defense Department contracts, with Swiftships currently building US Army landing craft. This was all great for hotels and restaurants in the area. There were three dredges under contract, one of which was currently underway. Two more were scheduled to begin in the first two weeks of January. Thirty-five million dollars was being invested at the Port on the East dock, ninety percent of which was being funded by the Department of Transportation and Development. Another fifteen million dollars was scheduled to be invested into the West Dock. After completion this would give 1,900' of waterfront.

Mr. Clarence Robinson with the Morgan City Housing Authority presented the Council with the annual PILOT (payment in lieu of taxes) check. He also submitted a copy of the October 2021 – September 2022 Fiscal Report (copy on file).

Mayor Dragna read the following statement into record: "Notice is hereby given that at its meeting to be held on Tuesday, January 24, 2023 at 6:00 PM at its regular meeting place, City Court Building, 7261 Hwy 182 East, Morgan City, Louisiana, the Morgan City Council plans to consider adopting a resolution ordering and calling an election to be held in the City o Morgan City, State of Louisiana, to authorize the levy of a sales and use tax therein."

Mayor Dragna asked the Council for permission to have a small fireworks show in conjunction with the Krewe of Galatea King & Queens Party/New Year's Eve Party at the Municipal Auditorium on December 31, 2022. A motion to approve the fireworks was made by Mr. Tamporello, seconded by Mr. Domangue, and voted unanimously in favor.

The minutes of the November 15, 2022 and December 8, 2022 meetings were submitted. There being no corrections, additions, or deletions, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Pastor Bias, seconded by Mr Hymel, and voted unanimously in favor.

Mrs. Deborah Garber, Finance Director, submitted the following financial statement for the period ending November 30, 2022.

**RE:** Comments related to summary of revenues and expenses compared to

budget for the period ended November 30, 2022.

Attached is a summary that compares our actual revenues and expenses to our operational budget for our major funds subject to budgetary control for the period ending November 30, 2022. The following comments are related thereto:

<u>General and Ancillary Funds</u>: These funds look very similar to prior month. The actual total revenues continue to come in over budget by \$1,108,905. Sales taxes in General Fund were over budget by \$533,000, Fines by \$145,000, and Parkway and Lake End Park by 178,000. Operating expenses are below budget by \$679,500. The net income, after transfers, of \$623,650 is a favorable variance of \$1,763,422 compared to the budget.

<u>Utility Fund</u>: Actual revenues are now over budget by \$1,634,728. The operational expenses are currently over budget by \$1,877,468. The purchased power cost is \$1,747,320 over budget and natural gas is over by \$260,000. The net loss, after transfers, of \$525,463 creates an unfavorable variance of \$193,715.

<u>Sanitation and Sewer Fund</u>: The operating revenues remain under budget by \$51,103, with total operating expenses over budget by \$4,876 The net income, after transfers, of \$931,872 leaves a favorable variance this month of \$432,230.

The next matter on the agenda was the canvassing of the election returns; whereupon,

The following resolution was offered by Mr. Hymel and seconded by Mr. Tamporello:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. R: 22-47**

A resolution providing for canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the special election held in the City of Morgan City, State of Louisiana, on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, to authorize the renewal of a sales and use tax therein

BE IT RESOLVED by the Morgan City Council (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the City of Morgan City, State of Louisiana (the "City"), that:

SECTION 1. <u>Canvass.</u> This Governing Authority does now proceed in open and public session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special election held in the City of Morgan City, State of Louisiana, on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022 (the "Election"), to authorize the renewal of a sales and use tax therein pursuant to the following proposition (the "Proposition"):

#### SALES TAX RENEWAL PROPOSITION

Shall the City of Morgan City, State of Louisiana (the "City"), be authorized to continue to levy a tax of three tenths of one percent (3/10 %) (the "Tax") (an estimated \$790,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), for a period of twelve (12) years, beginning January 1, 2024, upon the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental, the consumption, and the storage for use or consumption, of tangible personal property and on sales of services in the City, as defined by law, with the avails or proceeds of the Tax, after paying the reasonable and necessary expenses of administering and collecting the Tax, to be dedicated and used for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing, improving, resurfacing, maintaining and providing street drainage for public streets, alleys, sidewalks and public wharves, and acquiring equipment therefor?

This Governing Authority does further proceed to examine and canvass the returns of the Election thereof.

SECTION 2. <u>Election Results.</u> According to the official certified tabulation of votes cast at said Election, there was a total of **1,932** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the Proposition and a total of **1,146** votes cast **AGAINST** the Proposition, resulting in a majority of **786** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** the Proposition. The Proposition was therefore duly **CARRIED** by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified electors voting at the Election.

SECTION 3. <u>Promulgation of Election Result.</u> The results of said election shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law, after receipt from the Secretary of State's office of the actual costs of the election, as required by Act 205 of the Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana for the year 2019.

SECTION 4. <u>Declaration.</u> The foregoing results of the Election are hereby declared by this Governing Authority and shall be published as required by law.

SECTION 5. <u>Procès Verbal.</u> A *Procès Verbal* of the canvass of the returns of the Election shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office; another certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio* Recorder of Mortgages in and for the Parish of St. Mary, who shall record the same in the Mortgage Records of said Parish; and another copy thereof shall be retained in the archives of this Governing Authority.

This resolution having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:

There was found by said count and canvass that there was a total of **1,932** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** Proposition and a total of **1,146** votes cast **AGAINST** Proposition, as hereinabove set forth, and it was further found and determined that there was a majority of **786** votes cast **IN FAVOR OF** Proposition as hereinabove set forth.

Therefore, the Governing Authority did declare and proclaim and does hereby declare and proclaim in open and public session that the Proposition as hereinabove set forth was duly **CARRIED** by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified electors voting at the said special election held in the City on Tuesday, November 8, 2022.

The said special election shall be held at the polling places for the following precincts, which polls will open at six o'clock (6:00) a.m. and close at eight o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:541, to wit:

The polling places for the precincts set forth above are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the said election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, shall be those persons designated according to law.

The estimated cost of this election as determined by the Secretary of State based upon the provisions of Chapter 8-A of Title 18 and actual costs of similar elections is \$3,700.

The said special election will be held in accordance with the applicable provisions of Chapter 5, Chapter 6-A and Chapter 6-B of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, and the officers appointed to hold the said election, as provided in this Notice of Special Election, or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and designated in accordance with La.
