# OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS CITY OF MORGAN CITY OCTOBER 27, 2020

The Mayor and City Council of Morgan City, Louisiana, met at 6:00 pm (local time) in regular session, this date, in the Morgan City Municipal Auditorium Theater, 725 Myrtle Street, Morgan City, Louisiana.

There were present: Honorable Frank P. Grizzaffi, III Mayor; and Council Members Ron Bias, Steve Domangue, Tim Hymel, Mark Stephens and Louis J. Tamporello, Jr.

Absent: None

Also present were Mr. Marcus Folse, Chief Administrative Officer and Mr. Paul Landry, City Attorney.

The invocation was given by Revered Randy Plessela.

There was no Positive Image recipient for the month of October.

Mrs. Natalie Broussard addressed the Mayor and Council to announce her candidacy for 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Judge, Division "F".

Mr. Anthony "Tony" Saleme addressed the Mayor and Council to announce his candidacy for 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Judge, Division "F".

Mr. Pat Cloutier asked Mayor Grizzaffi if the Morgan City LEPA plant had been operational. Mayor Grizzaffi stated that he knew it had been down for repair recently, but he would contact Kevin Bihm with LEPA and get back to Mr. Cloutier with the answer.

The minutes of the September 22, 2020 and October 6, 2020 meetings were submitted. There being no corrections, additions, or deletions, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Pastor Bias, seconded by Mr. Domangue, and voted unanimously in favor.

Mrs. Deborah Garber, Finance Director, submitted the following financial statement for the period ending September 30, 2020.

RE: Comments related to summary of revenues and expenses compared to

budget for the period ended September 30, 2020.

Attached is a summary that compares our actual revenues and expenses to our operational budget for our major funds subject to budgetary control for the period ending September 30, 2020. The following comments are related thereto:

**General and Ancillary Funds**: Revenues remain over budget by \$100,900. Operating expenses are below budget by \$608,900. The net loss, after transfers, of \$1,659,400 is a favorable variance of \$709,800 compared to the budget.

<u>Utility Fund</u>: Actual revenues continue to be increasingly under budget by \$2,131,500, with operational expenses comparably under budget by \$2,055,300. The net income, after transfers, of \$635,300 creates an unfavorable variance again this month of \$49,700.

**Sanitation and Sewer Fund**: The operating revenues are \$59,400 over budget, with total operating expenses under budget by \$74,200. The net income, after transfers, of \$719,200 leaves a favorable variance this month of \$136,800.

Mayor Grizzaffi stated that the Galey house at 1430 Victor II Boulevard was still in disrepair. He said that at the September 25, 2018 council meeting this issue was first discussed. Nothing had been done since a tarp was placed on the roof in January of 2019. Mr. Galey stated that he was trying to secure prices to have the house torn down and requested time to complete that. A motion to allow Mr. Galey 60 days to secure prices to

have his house torn down was made by Mr. Tamporello, seconded by Pastor Bias and voted unanimously in favor.

The next matter on the agenda was the Surplus Equipment. Mayor Grizzaffi stated that with the replacement of all the utility meters in the City, there were about 40 pallets of utility meters that needed to be declared surplus and sold at auction; whereupon,
